#### **Position Summary**

The Primary Care Network (PCN) Planner works closely with Interior Health and the Division of Family Practice to plan a redesigned, more holistic, approach to the delivery of primary healthcare in the Lillooet and northern St'át'imc area. The position serves as the main point of communication between the PCN partners and the St'át'imc communities to ensure St'át'imc goals and values are represented in the planning and implementation of the PCN.

The position could be either full-time or part-time (20-25 hours per week) depending on the successful candidate's preferences.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- Provide direction to the PCN partners concerning St'át'imc community needs and priorities for consideration in PCN planning.
- Work with partners and stakeholders to identify gaps and barriers to health services and identify opportunities to close those gaps – through the introduction of specific positions, or through specific service models.

#### **Qualifications**

- Bachelor's degree in a related discipline,
- A minimum of three years' experience working in a health field and a collaborative, team-based environment,
- Knowledge of the principles and processes related to quality improvement.
- Demonstrated ability to develop effective working relationships and collaborate with key participants across a range of stakeholders.
